EDF Tower

Paris, France

Completed in April 2001, the EDF Tower is a 41-story, 624,414-square-foot office tower in La Défense, west of Paris. The architects Pei, Cobb, Freed & Partners designed the elliptical tower with a façade clad in alternating bands of stainless steel and lightly reflective glass panels. A special design feature is a conical shape carved into the building's base up to level 26.
